Basic Colours: Claret, White and Grey

Suppliers: BEAT school uniforms

ALL CLOTHES and **FOOTWEAR** must be **clearly marked** with your child's name.

EARLY YEARS UNIFORM

NURSERY

Claret School sweatshirt with logo
Plain dark grey (charcoal) tracksuit bottoms
Plain white polo shirt
Black school shoes (not trainers)
Book Bag

RECEPTION

Claret School sweatshirt with logo
Plain grey trousers or shorts
Plain grey pinafore or skirt
Plain white polo shirt
Black school shoes (not trainers)
Book Bag

Summer Uniform

Summer Dress (red & white check with short sleeves)
Summer dresses must have sleeves and be plain without motifs or over-elaborate white stitching or embroidery.

KEY STAGE 1 and 2 UNIFORM (Y1 to Y6)

Grey pinafore dress or grey skirt/ Grey school trousers or shorts
White Shirt (long or short sleeves)
School tie
Claret V-neck jumper or cardigan with school logo
Grey or black tights
Plain *white or grey* ankle or knee length socks (no trainer socks)
Black school shoes (no raised heels or boots)

Summer Uniform

Plain white polo shirt/white polo shirt with school logo
Summer Dress (red & white check with short sleeves)
Summer dresses must have sleeves and be plain without motifs or over-elaborate white stitching or embroidery.

ALL CHILDREN

Plain coloured coat with hood
Painting apron with sleeves/old shirt with sleeves (for art activities). **Not necessary for Nursery and Reception children (Y1 to Y6 only).**

PE/GAMES KIT

RECEPTION

Claret polo or t-shirt with school logo
Plain black sports shorts or skorts
Plain black tracksuit
Suitable trainers

KEY STAGE ONE (Y1 and Y2)

Claret polo or t-shirt with school logo
Plain black sports shorts or skorts
Plain black tracksuit (essential for outdoor games in cold weather)
Suitable trainers – outdoors

KEY STAGE TWO (Y3 to Y6)

Claret polo or t-shirt with school logo
Plain black sports shorts or skorts
White ankle length sports socks
Plain black tracksuit (essential for outdoor games in cold weather)
Suitable trainers – outdoors

ADDITIONAL UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

FOOTBALL BOOTS AND SHIN GUARDS

Shin guards and football boots are only required for children representing the school in football and hockey. These items are not needed for PE or Games in the school curriculum.

SPORTS FESTIVALS

For all children representing our school in festivals organised by the School Sports Partnership, full school PE kit is required to be worn. Any child without the correct kit is not permitted to participate.

HAIR

Long hair (shoulder length) must be tied back at all times using black, red, grey or white headbands and plain hair clips. No hard hair bands are to be worn in school.

JEWELLERY

We do not expect children to wear any kind of jewellery in school except a watch. Hoop earrings and chains are a real danger in PE. Children with pierced ears should wear simple plain studs. Preferably these should be removed during PE lessons or they will need to be taped.

EQUIPMENT

In KS2 children require a named pencil case with 2 pencils, a BLUE handwriting pen (Frixion style), pencil sharpener, rubber, 30 cm clear plastic rigid ruler, and a few coloured pencils. Children in Year 3 start writing in pencil until achieving their pen licence. Years 5 and 6 can also bring scissors, glue stick and highlighter pens. Correcting pens and tape are not allowed.

UPPER KS2 SCHOOL BAGS

When the children move into Upper Key Stage Two in Year 5 they need to bring a small rucksack or other suitable bag in place of the school book bag. The bag must be small enough to fit on their cloakroom peg.

BOOKS

Your child will regularly bring books home. Please encourage them in their care of books and help us by making sure they are well cared for and brought to and from school in a bag. The Early Years and KS1 should have a book bag which is available from the school's uniform supplier.

LOST PROPERTY

All named property is returned immediately to the owner. Unnamed property is kept in lost property (cupboard in the school foyer), parents are welcome to look through the lost property. Unclaimed items are displayed at the school gate in the last week of each term before it is donated to our second-hand uniform sale, disposed of to a charity shop or the clothing recycling project.
